The Howe Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session in a Zoom virtual meeting at 5:05 p.m. on April 16, 2020. Present: Chairman Dale Beaver, Vice Chairman Charles Burd, Supervisor Kathy Donahey, Secretary/Treasurer Nancy Cangioli and Solicitor Dave Jones.

Chairman Beaver called the meeting to order. Secretary Cangioli called the roll. All Supervisors were present.

A motion was made to approve the minutes for March 5, 2020 as presented; Beaver/Burd. Motion carried. A motion was made to approve the bills to be paid as presented; Beaver/Donahey. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

None was offered by email or telephone.

**NEW BUSINESS**

A motion was made to ratify the Covid-19 Declaration of Disaster Emergency declared on March 16, 2020; Beaver/Burd. Motion carried.

Spring cleanup day has been rescheduled to June 20, 2020.

A motion was made to grant a 90 day extension for the Johnson subdivision plan; Beaver/Donahey. Motion carried.

The Department of Labor and Industry conducted the 5 year audit on Tractor Supply, Hamilton Health and McDonalds and there were no findings. McDonalds was listed on being on McClure St. Supervisor Burd will write a letter to them to correct the mistake.

The audit findings for 2019 was that check 6353 to the Juniata Sewage Committee was shorted by .40 cents.

A motion was made authorizing Supervisor Beaver to spend up to \$1,500 for small tools and shop supplies for the township garage with the caveat that purchases will try to be made at Heller's; Beaver/Burd. Motion carried.

Solicitor Jones provided information on Senate Bill 841 to address issues relating to municipalities. He will send an email to summarize the bill.

The May 7<sup>th</sup> Board meeting has been moved to the May 21<sup>st</sup> date. Tar and chip bids will be due then.

Supervisor Burd announced the HTMA meeting for April 20<sup>th</sup> has been cancelled. The Juniata Sewage meeting for April 22<sup>nd</sup> has been cancelled. The next meeting is scheduled for June 4<sup>th</sup>.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 5:29 p.m.; Beaver/Burd. Motion carried.
