When do you need to obtain a Demolition Permit in Howe Township?

In many cases, Central Keystone Council of Governments (CK-COG) will issue Demolition Permits for occupied structures, both Residential and Commercial. CK-COG does not issue Demolition Permits for any accessory structures, such as a barn, implement shed or other outbuildings. In these cases (unoccupied structures), the Demolition Permit will be issued by Howe Township. You should contact the Township Secretary at the Township Office to obtain the required Demolition Permit. A completed application, which can be found here, along with the appropriate fee (refer to the current Fee Schedule) must be submitted to Howe Township. Phone: 717-444-3045; Email: howetwp@pa.net
