The Howe Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Hope Eternal Church at 2 Burd Rd, Newport at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 5, 2023. Present: Chairman Dale Beaver, Vice Chairman Charles Burd, Supervisor Kathy Donahey, Secretary/Treasurer Nancy Cangioli, Nancy Beaver, Luke Roman-Perry County Times

Secretary Cangioli called the roll. All Supervisors were present.

A motion was made to approve the business meeting minutes for December 1, 2022 as presented; Donahey/Burd. Motion carried.

A motion was made to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the bills as presented with the amendment to include the Tractor Supply amount of \$299.99 for the heater for the garage that was included in the balance but mistakenly left off the list; Burd/Donahey. Motion carried.

GOOD AND WELFARE

None was offered.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The application for APRA funds to the Perry County Commissioners is still pending.

The CD's at Pennian Bank were invested in 2 separate regular 15-month CDs at 4.22 %

The NBWA submitted the inspection reports for the fire hydrants in the township and the bill was paid for December.

The Public Hearing on the Conditional Use Application for Solar Renewable Energy, LLC will be held on January 10, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. at the Hope Eternal UM Church.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made to reappoint Frank Campbell as a member of the Municipal Authority for a 5-year term; Burd/Donahey. Burd-aye, Donahey-aye, Beaver-no. Motion carried.

MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY

Draft minutes from December 19, 2022 have been submitted and were reviewed by Supervisor Burd.

PPL has hooked up. 1 resident has hooked up and is waiting on the inspection. There are 3 residents

that have not hooked up and have been turned over to Solicitor Jones for action. The final inspection of the whole system by DEP was conducted and approved.

SOLICITOR REPORT

The Zoning Ordinance Sign Provision update is pending. A compilation of prior work efforts needs to be done before proceeding.

JUNIATA SEWAGE COMMITTEE

The 1st meeting will be held in February. Supervisor Burd will confirm with Bob Kratzer when the next round of pump outs will begin.

ZONING REPORT

The CK COG issued a permit to Judy Fasick for solar panels.

PLANNING COMMISSION

There was no meeting in December. Supervisor Donahey will contact their Secretary Pam Pollack for the November meeting minutes for the public hearing on January 10th. Chairman Beaver requested from the Office of the Budget an extension for the compliance for special conditions for the RACP grant and it was granted within 24 hours.

ROAD MASTER

The cable guiderail replacement on Acker Rd was completed by Chemung Supply. The inventory of the garage was completed.

OPEN FORUM

Luke Roman inquired about the extension for the RACP grant, where the property is for the public hearing on January 10th and clarification on the fee schedule.
