MESSAGE FROM GENERAL COUNSEL

PIRMA and our member municipalities have weathered challenging times over the past several years – an international pandemic, supply chain shortages of critical supplies, a difficult labor environment with fast-changing, unclear regulatory obligations, an uneasy inflationary economy, geopolitical issues that again highlight the importance of local cyber security measures and an ever-shifting legal environment with novel claims raised against our members. Despite these challenges, PIRMA, through its Board and consultants, have proven to be creative in promoting PIRMA's core principles. We provide comprehensive liability protection for our members; we zealously defend claims brought against our members with experienced, well-regarded legal counsel who are at the forefront of municipal law; we engage in robust measures to educate members and provide unmatched risk management and loss control services.

PIRMA continues to bolster its risk management and loss control efforts by enhancing its online resources, as it rolls out educational resources, legislative tracking and loss control grants. PIRMA's defense counsel continue to present at educational seminars to public officials and municipal employees through local, county and statewide municipal associations, including the Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs and the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors. These programs have expanded with PIRMA's Third Thursday sessions and the Legal Access program. With more than twenty-four Third Thursday sessions thus far, these programs have provided critical legal educational updates to our members. In addition to the attendees participating

on the particular presentation day, these sessions have been viewed online more than 200 times. These types of initiatives set PIRMA apart, demonstrating its proactive approach to risk management and protecting member interests. These educational programs promote loss control by sensitizing public officials and municipal employees on the various risks and pitfalls associated with their day-to-day operations. I encourage you to attend these programs. The education they afford will be a significant benefit to you and in fulfilling your municipal roles. Additionally, PIRMA's service providers are happy to provide assistance, training, risk management and loss control training.

The coming year will undoubtedly present many new challenges and opportunities for PIRMA and our member municipalities. We continue to track the legal attacks to the liability cap under the Tort Claims Act and the corresponding legislative efforts to amend it. Indeed, a fresh challenge to the cap is currently making its way through the Pennsylvania Appellate Courts, with the current members of the bench having previously signaled impatience with legislative efforts to address it. Any changes, while likely, could have a lasting effect on the scope of the claims brought against our members. It will be critical to actively track and participate in the statewide consideration of the issue in order to protect our members and be proactive in responding to any legislative change.

Separately, we need to remain cognizant of the impact of national news events on claims of police bias and use of force incidents (which has prompted calls for legislative reform and

created a stigma faced by municipal police departments). Claimants are also continuing in their efforts to use the Right to Know Act process to further their claims. The plaintiff's bar continues to press hard seeking substantial recoveries based on novel theories of liability and municipal responsibilities. PIRMA's defense counsel will continue to put forth formidable, member-driven defenses and provide knowledgeable representation to effectively meet these challenges.

The inflationary economy and an increase in state-mandated requirements has increased the financial challenges facing municipalities. The exposures associated with volatile weather, cyber risks, and social inflation in the form of escalating jury verdicts have caused reinsurance markets to adjust pricing upward and limit their coverages. PIRMA's dedicated team will continue to work diligently to help PIRMA's members stay abreast of these exposures and challenging markets.

FREE CONSULTATIONS

PIRMA members are eligible **for up to 120 minutes of free legal consultation annually** on a wide range of matters, including employment issues, wage and hour questions, zoning and land use matters, law enforcement and civil liability issues, open records and open meetings laws, public works liability issues, contract review and recommendations, governmental immunities and much more. LIVE AND ON-DEMAND WEBINARS

POLICY CREDITS FOR POLICE TRAINING

When members utilize services such as Power DMS, LLRMI, and Lexipol, policy credits are available. The credits reduce the member's Law Enforcement Liability premium. Accredited departments are eligible for further credits.

REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS

IN-PERSON EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS + 5% POLICY DISCOUNT

PIRMA offers ½ day in-person regional educational workshops throughout the Commonwealth. These workshops include updates on PIRMA and presentations from PIRMA's experienced defense counsel team on hot topics. Members that attend receive policy credits.



RESOURCE ELIBRARY

In 2021, the Resource eLibrary received a refresh – a new look and feel as well as improved functionality and searchability. We also added a number of new resources to the eLibrary in 2022.

Given the increased focus on cyber issues, the risk control team created 25 sets of cyber best practices and checklists to help members with cyber security that are now included in

the Documents section of the Resource eLibrary, including the following:

- Data Encryption
- Imaging and Printing
- Cybersecurity Awareness
- Internet, Email
- New Hires (IT BP)

In addition, best practices and checklists were added on topics such as golf courses, vehicle storage, splash pads, dog parks and situational awareness.

We also added a number of courses to the Public Entity University, a vendor-driven portal that provides comprehensive training on the topics faced by our members. In 2022, the focus was on driving safety, with the addition of the following new courses:

- Space and Time Management
- Driving with Distractions
- Managing Speed
- Avoiding Collisions While Backing & Parking

CYBER PORTAL

Through the Resource eLibrary, PIRMA members have access to the Cyber Portal that provides members with a number of cybersecurity resources. One of the resources is a short cyber assessment that provides solutions via policies for cyber security deficiencies noted in the assessment. In addition, PIRMA members can access items such as:

- Customizable Cybersecurity Incident Response Plans
- An IT Security Audit Kit that provides sample policy templates and operating procedures for HR, IT and Operations departments

The Cyber Portal also provides members with online cyber trainings and essential webinars, including titles such as:

- End User Cyber Security Fundamentals Series – Best Practices
- End User Cyber Security Fundamentals Series – Information Protection
- End User Cyber Security Fundamentals Series – Key Security Concepts

RISK CONTROL

RISK CONTROL ON-SITE SURVEYS

Members receive on-site visits from credentialed risk management professionals that include a review of operations and facilities. Certified playground safety inspections are also performed. The survey identifies and recommends specific actions that members can take to reduce risk. Resources to help in risk reduction are provided.

PROPERTY EVALUATIONS

Member buildings are valued on an as-needed and requested basis. Members receive peace of mind knowing that their property is properly valued and adjusted for inflation and other building cost variables.

LOSS CONTROL GRANT

UP TO \$5,000 FOR MEMBERS

PIRMA has an annual grant program where members can apply for a grant of up to \$5,000 to help pay for projects or trainings that reduce risk and fund risk management projects.

SAFETY COMMITTEE TRAINING

ANNUAL TRAININGS

PIRMA's loss control personnel can provide the annual training required for certified workplace safety committees and help in establishing committees.
